

2941 Urban Indy 2220 Urban Indy In 2024, Enroll Indy partnered with The Mind Trust and the Indiana Department of Education to develop a unified enrollment process for Summer Learning Labs in Indianapolis and across various regions in the state. Modeled after the Open Seat Portal—used by families seeking schools after the OneMatch lottery—the system allowed families to use a single application to claim a seat at any participating site within their region.

Our enrollment specialists supported dozens of families by submitting applications over the phone for those who needed assistance.

According to a report from The Mind Trust, "Summer Learning Labs serve the highest-need populations in their respective regions. Most students enrolled in the program are students from low-income households or students of color.

Across all service regions, 78% identified as students of color and 69% qualified for free or reduced lunch."

This streamlined enrollment process helped us further our vision of providing equitable access to all families across the City and the State.
